



2025 Undergraduate Scholarship Criteria

Eligibility:

1. Must be a fully initiated undergraduate member *in good standing* with the chapter.
2. Must be enrolled as a full-time student at UTSA (minimum 12 credit hours per semester).
3. Must have completed at least one full semester as an active member before applying.
4. Scholarship is open to Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors.

Academic Standards:

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
2. Must maintain good academic standing with the university (not on probation or suspension).

Leadership & Involvement:

1. Demonstrated involvement in chapter activities, committees, or leadership roles.
2. Participation in at least one campus or community organization outside of the fraternity.
3. Service contribution to philanthropy, community service, or mentoring new members.
4. Must have achieved at least one level of ritual proficiency.

Application Materials:

1. Completed scholarship application form.
2. Unofficial transcript (official if awarded).
3. Short essay (500–750 words) **OR** a 2-3 minute video answering:
 - How has membership in Xi-Delta shaped your personal, academic, and leadership growth?
 - How do you plan to give back to the chapter and fraternity as a whole?
4. One letter of recommendation (from a professor, advisor, or alumni brother – **cannot be a member of the Alumni EC**).

Selection Criteria:

- Academic Achievement (40%)
- Leadership & Involvement (30%)
- Essay & Personal Statement (20%)
- Recommendation Letter (10%)

Award Conditions:

- Scholarship funds must be applied toward tuition, books, or academic-related expenses.
- Recipients must remain in good standing with the fraternity and university throughout the academic year.
- Alumni Association reserves the right to revoke the award if eligibility is not maintained.
